Sub: Removal of import load FCL containers.

The lock gate of Kidderpore Docks (KPD) will be taken up for maintenance from 7th March 2008 and it will remain inoperative till 18th April 2008. Consequent to this, no container vessel will be allocated at KP Dock I (West) during the above period.

In view of the above and also in view of delayed clearance of containers by the Importers / their C&F Agents, it has been decided that **no** import load FCL container (excluding container destined for CFS and ICD) will be delivered from N S Docks after 10 days from the Last Landing Date (LLD) of the vessels. Delivery of such containers will have to be taken compulsorily from the Off dock CFSs. Importers / their C&F Agents, not sure of clearance of containers from N S Dock within the above stipulated period, are advised not to file delivery documents with port. They should inform their respective Container Agents to remove containers to the Off dock CFSs so that delivery can be taken by them from those CFSs after filing documents thereat.

All concerned are requested to take note of the above in continuation of this office circular of even number dated 14/02/08 and arrange to remove all import FCL containers (excluding containers destined for CFSs and ICDs) from N S Dock accordingly. Container Agents may even remove containers to KP Dock I West during the period the lock gate remains under maintenance, against specific permission from Port and Customs.

The above will be effective from 1st March 2008 and will continue till further orders.
