


STEPS need to follow for importing NIC Chain certificates in Internet Explorer for accessing IPAPCS Application:


Step-1:

Open Internet Explorer & type <https://nicca.nic.in> for downloading NIC chain certificates.




Step-2:

Click on **Repository** Tab -> Certificate Chain (CCA, NICCA & NIC sub-CA Cert) as mentioned below.




Step-3:

Click on Download button for downloading Chain Certificates.



Step-4:


Click on **Download Certificate Chain** Link for downloading certificates.




Step-5:

After downloading certificates, import the same in Internet Explorer.

(Tools -> Internet Options -> Content Tab -> Certificates)







Step-6:

After click on Certificates, go to Other people tab and try to import the downloaded certificates (.cer) in IE.

Certificates need to import in Internet Explorer.

1. NIC sub-CA for NIC 2011.cer
2. NIC CA 2011.cer
3. CCA India 2011.cer



Step-7:

After importing all the 3 certificates, type PCS URL : www.indianpcs.gov.in in IE.
