➤ All the major efficiency parameters improved both at KDS and HDC in 2014-2015 vis-à-vis 2013-2014.

## 6. <u>PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS</u>:

#### A. Cargo Traffic

- ➤ During 2014-15, KoPT handled 46.292 million tonnes (mt) of traffic (KDS 15.282 mt, HDC 31.010 mt) against 41.386 mt (KDS-12.875 mt, HDC-28.511 mt) in 2013-2014, i.e. a commendable rise of 4.906 mt (11.85%) vis-a-vis 4.65% growth registered by Indian Major Ports during the same period.
- ➤ **KoPT recorded growth in 2014-15** for LPG, Vegetable Oil, Other Liquids, Iron Ore, Manganese Ore/Slag, Fertiliser, Rock Phosphate, Sulphur, Limestone, Coking Coal, Petroleum Coke, Other Coal /Coke, Dolomite, Iron & Steel, Pulse, Container (both Tonnage and TEUs), IVW/IWAI Traffic, etc.
- ➤ Growth was registered at KDS in 2014-15 for Vegetable Oil, Other Liquids, Manganese Ore, Fertiliser, Rock Phosphate, Limestone, Coking Coal, Petroleum Coke, Other Coal/Coke, Pulse, Container (both Tonnage and TEUs), IVW Traffic, etc.
- ➤ At HDC, traffic increased in 2014-15 primarily for LPG, Vegetable Oil, Other Liquids, Iron Ore, Manganese Ore / Slag, Fertiliser, Rock Phosphate, Sulphur, Limestone, Coking Coal, Other Coal/Coke, Petroleum Coke, Iron & Steel, Dolomite, General Cargo, IWAI Traffic.

## **B.** Container Traffic

- ➤ Kolkata Port handled 6,30,095 TEUs in 2014-15 (highest ever) against 5,62,020 TEUs in 2013-2014 registering an impressive growth of 12.11% (vis-à-vis 6.71% growth of major ports) and ranked Third among Major Ports.
- ➤ KDS created history in container handling in 2014-15 by handling the highest container traffic i.e. 5,28,167 TEUs since the inception of containerization at KDS in 1979.
- ➤ There was a record shift productivity of 427 moves by two MHCs at 4 NSD during 3rd shift on 23.03.15 on MV Hanna Marie (Voy-009). It surpassed the previous productivity of 409 moves achieved by 2 MHCs on Hanna Marie (Voy-008) during 3rd shift of 08.03.15.
- ➤ Kolkata Port was adjudged the winner of 'Container Handling Port of the Year' at the Shipping Times-Eastern Star Awards held at Kolkata on 7.1.15 in recognition of its excellence in container handling. Incidentally, in the 5th South East Cargo & Logistics Awards 2013 also Kolkata Port was adjudged Container Handling Port of the Year.
- ➤ M/s Bharat Kolkata Container Terminals Private Ltd., a wholly owned unit of PSA International, has commenced container handling operation at KDS from December 2014.

## C. Comparative Performance

➤ Growth at KoPT in Fertiliser, Raw Materials for Fertiliser and Coking Coal was 114.57%, 45% and 11.67%, respectively during 2014-15 vis-a-vis 2013-14 against 29.67%, 11.39% and 0.22% recorded by all Major Ports.

## D. Ship Traffic

In 2014-2015, KoPT handled 3259 ships - the **highest** among Indian Major Ports.

## E. Railway Traffic:

- ➤ During 2014-15, KoPT handled an all time high rail-borne traffic of 27.11 mt (KDS 5.18 mt, HDC 21.93 mt) against 23.88 mt (KDS-4.25 mt, HDC-19.63 mt) in 2013-2014 i.e. a significant rise of 3.23 mt (13.53%).
- ➤ At KDS, number of trains received and despatched in March'15 was 128 and 120, respectively and at HDC, 469 trains were received and 470 trains were despatched in March'15.
