5. <u>PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS</u>

A. Cargo Traffic:

- > During April-June 2016, KoPT handled a cargo throughput of 12.242 million tonnes (mt). Kolkata Dock System (KDS) handled 3.999 mt and Haldia Dock Complex (HDC) handled 8.243 mt. in Apr-Jun'16.
- ➤ KoPT registered growth in Apr-Jun'16 vis-a-vis Apr-Jun'15 in respect of POL(Crude), Other Liquid Cargo, Manganese Ore, Other Ore, Fertiliser, Limestone, Fly Ash, Pulse, Container TEUs & Tonnage, Other Miscellaneous Cargo etc.
- ➤ Growth was recorded at KDS in Apr-Jun'16 for POL(Product), Other Liquid Cargo, Fertiliser, Fly Ash, Pulse, Container TEUs & Tonnage whereas at HDC, traffic increased for POL(Crude), Vegetable Oil, Other Liquid Cargo, Manganese Ore, Other Ore, Limestone, Petroleum Coke, Fly Ash, Container (TEUs & Tonnage), Other Miscellaneous Cargo, etc.

B. Container Traffic:

- ➤ KoPT handled 1,87,284 TEUs in Apr-Jun'16 vis-à-vis 1,48,176 TEUs in Apr-Jun'15, registering the highest growth of 26.39% among Indian Major Ports (against 6.23% growth registered by Major Ports). KoPT ranked 3rd amongst all Indian Major Ports in terms of Container traffic during Apr-Jun'16.
- ➤ KDS of KoPT handled an all time record monthly container throughput of 56,996 TEUs in May'16 surpassing the previous highest of 53,160 TEUs in Aug'15.

C. Comparative Performance:

➤ KoPT ranked first in terms of Coking & Other Coal/Coke handling and second in Other Liquid Cargo handling amongst Indian Major Ports in Apr-Jun'16.

D. Ship Traffic:

> In Apr-Jun'16, KoPT handled 849 ships—the highest among Indian Major Ports.

E. Railway Traffic:

- ➤ In Apr-Jun'16, KoPT handled rail-borne traffic of 6.11mt (KDS 1.48 mt, HDC 4.63 mt). In this period, 423 trains were received and 335 despatched at KDS and at HDC, 986 trains received and 990 despatched.
- ➤ Record handling of 5,72,757 MTs by rail at KDS achieved in May'16 (by 286 trains inward and outward) surpassing previous highest handling of 5,15,765 MTs (by 258 trains) in Jan'15.

F. Major Achievements:

- > KDS is giving concession in wharfage for domestic cars coming by Ro-Ro vessels w.e.f. 7.6.16 to promote Coastal Shipping.
- ➤ During the course of the review meeting presided by Secretary(Shipping) on 12.5.2016, Kolkata Port was awarded the 3rd position in terms of highest growth rate in traffic in 2015-16.
- ➤ KoPT adjudged Container Port for the year 2015-16 by EXIM Group and awarded Trophy & Certificate on 6.5.16 at Kolkata.
- ➤ Shipping through Eden Channel resumed since 18.09.15 with two inward vessels M.V. Tina & M.V. Cape Kasos. Eden channel has become fully operational from 29.02.16 for movement of all ships to/ from Haldia. 1023 vessels (508 inward; 515 outward) have passed through the channel during April-June'16.
- > The strengthening of India Bangladesh economic co-operation achieved a new high with the historic maiden movement of goods to N-E states using India-Bangladesh river protocol route taking place in June 2016 when a cargo vessel from Kolkata, with a consignment for Tripura, reached Ashuganj Port on Meghna river in Comilla district of Bangladesh. Goods from Kolkata for Tripura discharged at Ashuganj are to be transported by road (32 kms) to Agartala. Agreements with Bangladesh for use of Inland Waterway, Coastal shipping and Bangladesh Ports operationalised for short cut transit to North East states.
- > KoPT observed International Day of Yoga on 21.06.16 with enthusiastic participation of officials.
