## 5. <u>PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS</u>

### A. Cargo Traffic:

- KoPT handled 36.47 million tonnes of traffic in Apr-Oct'19 vis-à-vis 35.237 mt in Apr-Oct'18 registering a growth of 3.50% higher than 0.44% growth for Major Ports. HDC handled 26.079 mt during Apr-Oct'19 recording a growth of 4.78% 3rd highest among Major Ports. KDS handled 10.391 mt Apr-Oct'19 registering a growth of 0.43%.
- KoPT recorded growth in Apr-Oct'19 in respect of LPG, Vegetable Oil, Iron Ore, Manganese Ore/Slag, Other Ore, Fertiliser, Sulphur, Fly Ash, Other Coal/Coke, Petroleum Coke, Container, IVW Traffic, etc.

#### B. Container Traffic:

- KoPT handled 5,09,915 TEUs in Apr-Oct'19 vis-à-vis 4,95,977 TEUs in Apr-Oct'18, registering 2.81% growth and ranked 3<sup>rd</sup> amongst all Indian Major Ports in terms of Container Traffic.
- In October, 2019, KDS achieved highest ever monthly container handling of 62,710 TEUs which is 2,238 TEUs more than the previous highest of 60,472 TEUs handled in August, 2019.

#### C. Comparative Performance:

- **>** KoPT ranked 5<sup>th</sup> in Apr-Oct'19 in overall cargo handling amongst Indian Major Ports.
- > KoPT ranked 1<sup>st</sup> in Coking/Other Coal, 2<sup>nd</sup> in Other Liquids and 3<sup>rd</sup> in Container handling among Major Ports.

#### D. Ship Traffic:

In Apr-Oct'19, KoPT handled 2046 ships - the highest among Indian Major Ports. 2562 vessels (1275 inward; 1287 outward) passed through Eden channel in Apr-Oct'19 to / from Haldia.

### E. Railway Traffic:

Apr-Oct'19, KoPT handled rail-borne traffic of 16.44 mt. (KDS-2.91 mt & HDC-13.53 mt) against 16.485 mt. (KDS-3.395 mt & HDC-13.09 mt) in Apr-Oct'18. In Apr-Oct'19, 672 trains were received and 678 despatched at KDS; at HDC, 2703 trains were received and 2704 were despatched..

#### F. Major Achievements:

- Hon'ble Union Minister of Shipping (Independent Charge) Shri Mansukh Mandaviya inaugurated the RFID Operation at KDS, CCTV Operations at KDS & Rabindra Setu and three Truck Parking Terminals at KDS. The RFID system will provide single window system to port users for obtaining permit / passes through cashless transactions.
- KoPT observed 'Vigilance Awareness Week' (28.10.19 to 02.11.19) with thrust on integrity & work ethics in empowering individuals, organization, etc. for improved transparency. Chairman and KoPT Officers/employees took Integrity Pledge. Customer Grievance Redressal camp, Interactive sessions, Seminars, Quiz competitions were organised both at KDS & HDC.
- KoPT observed 'Rashtriya Ekta Diwas' on the occasion of Birth anniversary of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel on 31.10.19. Chairman, Dy.Chairman, Officers/employees of KoPT took pledge and Unity March was organised both at KDS & HDC.
- River cruise was organized from Indenture Memorial Jetty, a historic place with an old Clock Tower on KoPT land at Khidirpur as a part of KoPT's efforts to promote cruise tourism and Ganges Voyage 2, operated by private tour operator, was flagged off on 12.10.19.
- > On 3.10.19, MT Jag Abha discharged 26706 MT of HSD at Berth 2 of HDC highest ever discharge of HSD in a single day.
- Fixed Window Berthing of container vessels at MHC berths introduced at KDS for feeder operators through open tender. The Monday arrival - Wednesday sailing Window has been won by Bengal Tiger Lines and Wednesday-Friday window, by Far Shipping. Friday-Sunday window to be operational shortly. This is expected to improve efficiency and volume of cargo.
- To improve employees' participation in management and utilize their potential, KoPT organized an in-house 'Ideabox Challenge' competition. Top ideas included amphibious pilot launches, park-o-mats, digital library, rooftop restaurants, etc. Sri Gopal Krishna, IAS, Secretary (Shipping), GoI appreciated the efforts and felicitated the winners on 4.9.19.
- On 14.9.19, HDC flagged off 2<sup>nd</sup> GPWIS rake of Rungta after maiden loading of this rake. Rungta Mines has placed 2 rakes under GPWIS, each comprising 58 BOX NHL for Coal loading from Haldia and for bringing Iron Ore from the mines.
- Under the guidance from MoS and as a part of Swachhta Pakhwada, various works were undertaken by KoPT during 16-30 Sept'19 with active participation of key stakeholders.
- On 17.9.19, HDC of KoPT received National Safety Award Runners Up 2017 for safe on-board Port Operation from Hon'ble Union Minister of State for Labour & Employment at Vigyan Bhawan, New Delhi.
- Under the aegis of "Jal Shakti Abhiyan" at CISF Unit, rain water storage by development of a pond, ground recharge system by installing drums and fruit bearing tree plantations were organised by KoPT.
- Container operations started at KP Docks, KDS, after more than a decade, with MV Trans Samudera from Bangladesh, discharging containers at 6 KPD.
- Interchanging of Lock Gate work has recently been executed at HDC. The outer Lock Gate was replaced with a new one, which is functioning after 25 years a historic occasion for HDC.
- > Mechanisation of 3 NSD Berth at KDS which brings an additional berth, apart from 4, 5 & 8 NSD under MHC operation.
