The matter is taken up today for final disposal. It is the case of Syama Prasad Mookerjee Port, Kolkata [erstwhile Kolkata Port Trust], hereinafter referred to as KoPT, Applicant herein, that a monthly term lease was granted to Sri Bhutnath Shaw (O.P), on certain terms and conditions in respect of land msg. about 30.379 Sq.m situated at 67/50 Strand Bank Road, Cal-7, Thana-Posta, District-Calcutta, comprised under Plate No.SB-95 and O.P violated the condition of such tenancy by way of not making payment of rental dues to KoPT. It is also the case of KoPT that in gross violation of the said tenancy O.P has erected unauthorised structures on the demised land, carried out addition & alteration of the said building/shed/godown and also sublet/sold/ transferred/ assigned the tenancy right without having any authority under law. It is argued on behalf of KoPT that O.P has no authority under law to occupy the public premises after expiry of the period as mentioned in the notice to quit dated 18.07.2000 and O.P is liable to pay damages for unauthorised enjoyment of the Port property in question.

This Forum formed its opinion to proceed against O.P. under the relevant provisions of the Act and issued Show Cause Notice U/S 4 of the Act (for adjudication of the prayer for order of eviction etc.) and Show Cause Notice U/S-7(for adjudication of the prayer for recovery of arrear rental dues etc.) both dated 09.09.2013(vide Order No. 02 dated 12.12.2012) as per rule made under the Act.

After issuance of the aforesaid notice, on the scheduled date of appearance and filing of reply to the Show Cause i.e on 20.11.2013 and subsequently thereafter, O.P. did

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not appear before the Forum for giving reply to the Show Cause. However, the record depicts that such Notice had been sent to O.P both by hand and Registered Post as per addresses available on record.

The Postal Services to the recorded address of O.P returned undelivered to the Forum with a mark 'addressee Moved' but it reveals from the report of the Process Server dated 12.09.2013 that the Show Cause Notice/s u/s 4 & 7 were affixed on the subject premises on 12.09.2013 at about 2:10 P.M. It is also seen that one Samir Polley was appeared before the Forum on behalf of O.P on 17.02.2014 and thereafter, with a prayer for time to file his reply to the Show Cause. However, apart from a liquidation scheme (Dated 05.03.2014), no reply to the Show Cause was filed by O.P. or any other interested person. Moreover, said Samir Polley also failed to file his Letter of Authority and proof of Identity before this Forum to represent the instant matter on behalf of O.P. When all the efforts for procuring the attendance of O.P remain futile, a decision was taken to publish a Notice in a widely circulated News Paper for a notice to all concerned about the pendency of the instant proceeding in order to give further chances to O.P. to appear before the Forum and to represent their case. Such Notice was published in the classified column of 'The Telegraph' on 27.11.2014 fixing the ultimate date of O.P's appearance on 24.12.2014. But all the efforts went into vain as the O.P failed to appear before the Forum despite publication of such Notice in the News Paper.

Now in view of the spirit laid down in the Public Premises Act, 1971 for speedy and summary disposal of the case and further considering the continuous non appearance of O.P in spite of sufficient opportunities

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being given and after exhaustion of all available means of service, this Forum finds no need to keep the matter pending and final Order was reserved in the matter on 07.11.2016. Now this Forum has decided to adjudicate the matter ex-parte.

As O.P has repeatedly failed to appear before this Forum and no reply to the Show Cause Notice.u/s 4 & 7 of the Act has been filed as yet, I have no bar to accept the claim of KoPT on account of unauthorised occupation of O.P into the Public Premises in question. I think that it is a fit case for issuing Order of eviction u/s 5 of the Act on the following grounds:-

- That O.P or any other person interested in the property has failed to file any reply to the Show Cause Notice/s U/S 4 & 7 of the Act in spite of sufficient chances being provided to them.
- 2) That O.P. has violated the condition of said monthly term lease as granted by the Port authority by way of not making payment of rental dues and taxes to KoPT, for a prolonged period.

ACCORDINGLY, Department is directed to draw up formal order of eviction u/s. 5 of the Act as per Rule made there under, giving 15 days time to O.Ps' and any person/s whoever may be in occupation to vacate the premises. I make it clear that all person/s whoever may be in occupation are liable to be evicted by this order and the Port Authority is entitled to claim damages for unauthorized use and enjoyment of the property against O.Ps' in accordance with Law up to the date of recovery of possession of the same.

It is my considered view that a sum of Rs.72,125.27 (Rupees Seventy two Thousand One hundred twenty-five and paise twenty seven only) for the period 01.07.1983 to 31.08.2000 (both days inclusive) is due and recoverable from O.P. by the Port authority on account of rental dues and O.P. must have to pay such dues to KoPT on or before. $7.09.22^{1}$ Such dues attract compound interest @ 6.20 % per annum, which is the current rate of interest as per the Interest Act, 1978 (as gathered by me from the official website of the State Bank of India) from the date of incurrence of liability, till the liquidation of the same, as per the adjustment of payments, if any made so far by O.P., in terms of KoPT's books of accounts.

I find that KoPT has made out an arguable claim against O.P., founded with sound reasoning, regarding the damages/compensation to be paid for the unauthorised occupation. I make it clear that KoPT is entitled to claim damages against O.P. for unauthorized use and occupation of the public premises right upto the date of


