Subject / Work title : **“Supply and Operation of 2 no. Ambulance on hiring basis for KDS for 3 years”**

It is noted that no intending bidders attended the Pre-bid meeting held on 27.09.2018.

However, certain short comings / mismatches that have crept in the tender document have been clarified. They are as under:

i	Clause XIV of page 10 of tender document	The 1 st para stands deleted.
ii	Clause 2(b) of page 13 of tender document	2nd sub-para of Clause 2(b) of page 13 of tender document to be read as:- “Micro & Small enterprises (MSEs) registered with NSIC: (i) Micro & Small Enterprises (MSEs) registered with NSIC (under single point registration scheme) or Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) are exempted from depositing cost of Tender Document and Earnest Money. (ii) If Micro and Small Enterprise (MSEs) registered with NSIC or MSME intends to participate in the tender, for the items they are not registered with NSIC, they will have to deposit cost of tender document, full amount of earnest money as per NIT. Otherwise, their offer will not be considered. ” (iii) Copy of valid NSIC Certificate for MSEs/MSMEs has to be submitted along with bid.”
iii	Clause 2(c) of page 13 of tender document	The 1 st para stands deleted.
iv	Clause 14 of page 16 of tender document	It is clarified that the drivers and attendants of ambulances have been considered as “unskilled labours” by Kolkata Port Trust. Kolkata Port Trust follows minimum wages as per Notification of Government of India.

v	Clause 4.2.1 of page 19 of tender document	<p>The para should be read as</p> <p>“<u>Taxes and Duties</u>: The rate quoted by the tenderers should be considered to be all inclusive, except GST. GST will be paid extra at applicable rates at the time of supply of goods/services.”</p>
vi	Clause 5.1.8 of page-21 of tender document	<p>Clause 5.1.8 of page-21 of tender document to be read as:</p> <p>“The two ambulances intended to be supplied, should not be registered with Motor Vehicles Department of Govt. of West Bengal prior to 01.03.2015”.</p>
vii	Clause 27 at page 28 of tender document	<p>The Sub-para (before “Note”) of Clause 27 at page 28 of tender document to be read as:</p> <p>“Escalation will be allowed on the km actually covered up to 3000 km. (even if the total km actually covered by an ambulance is less than / equal to 3000 km in a calendar month).”</p>
viii	Annexure-D’ page no.31 of Scope of Work & Specification of tender document	<p>The first para of page 31 to be read as:</p> <p>“The work comprises supply and operation of two nos. ambulance on hiring basis at KDS for 3 years. The supplied ambulances will have to be petrol driven & company-built on the chasis of ‘Maruti Omni/EECO’ or any other equivalent model”.</p>

All other terms and conditions of the tender shall remain unaltered.

The above Addendum shall be a part of the Tender Document as per terms of the original tender and the same shall have to be submitted alongwith the techno-commercial part of the tender.
