The Supply and Delivery work as described in the tender shall be executed in Haldia and in accordance with the attached General Conditions of Contract, Special Conditions of Contract, Particular Specifications & detailed Bill of Quantities.

5.1 **EARNEST MONEY:**

Earnest Money and cost of tender document are to be physically deposited at the office of Tendering Authority (Sr. Dy. 5.7 DETAILED SCRUTINY OF E-TENDERERS:

Authority in signing the documents for submission of Tender / Offer: 18 All documents to be uploaded by the bidder should be signed under official seal by — In case the Tender is submitted by a Proprietorship Firm, the same should be signed either by 18.1 Proprietor or other person, holding a valid Power of Attorney from the Proprietor, in connection with this Tender. Upon occurrence of such cause and upon its termination, the party alleging that it has been rendered unable as aforesaid, shall notify the other party in writing immediately but not later 7 (seven) days after the alleged beginning thereof, giving full particulars and satisfactory evidence in support of its claim.

35 JURISDICTION OF COURT:

The contract shall be governed by all relevant Indian Acts applicable within the jurisdiction of High Court at Kolkata.

36 QUANTITY: -

The quantities of the item(s) as mentioned in the Bill of Quantities are only indicative.
