Sub. : Recovery of compensation/damage in case of use of yard/shed space inside the Docks for transit storage of cargo by licensees beyond the stipulated licence period.

Ref. : This office All Concerned circulars of even No. dated 17.09.2010 and 19.11.2010.

Kindly be informed that the Board of Trustees vide Resolution No.57 of 05.05.2011 has sanctioned

(A) Continuance of the following decisions taken earlier, even from the date the new Rent schedule approved by TAMT has come into effect (i.e. 07.04.2011).

(i) Allowing month to month extension of licence in respect of export including coastal export cargo with retrospective effect from 07.04.2011 without charging any compensation,


(ii) Granting licence upto a period of 60 days in case the volume of import cargo exceeds 10,000 tonnes in respect of dry-bulk cargo and 5,000 tonnes in respect of all other cargo carried by the vessel arriving at KPD/NSD after which compensation at 3 times the rate as per prevailing SOR for 30 days, 5 times the rate as per prevailing SOR for next 30 days and 10 times the rate as per prevailing SOR thereafter will be applicable, with retrospective effect from 07.04.2011.

It has also been decided in connection with (ii) above that -

(a) Consignees will have the option for licence upto a period of 30 days even if the volume of import cargo exceeds 10,000 tonnes in respect of dry bulk cargo and 5,000 tonnes in respect of all other cargo carried by the vessel arriving at KPD/NSD and

(b) Licence upto a period of 60 days will be granted in case the declared parcel load of the mother vessel fulfils the criteria mentioned at Item (a) above and the entire parcel load belongs to a single consignee. If there is more than one consignee, each consignee is to fulfil the criteria individually.

(B) Allowing month to month extension of licence in case of Nepal bound cargo with effect from 05.05.2011.
