# SMP, Kolkata (erstwhile KoPT) Highlights of Achievements in APRIL 2023

#### I. NOTABLE ACHIEVEMENTS / DEVELOPMENTS


Sharing with Press/Electronic Media, the significant highlights of achievements of SMPK in 2022-2013

Addressing the representatives of print/electronic media on 4.4.2023, Chairman, SMPK shared the following highlights of achievements for 2022-23.

- ➤ Highest Cargo Traffic of 65.66 MMT in FY 2022-23 in the history of SMPK.
- ➤ HDC's handling of 48.61 MMT in FY 2022-23, is highest in its history.
- ➤ Highest ever absolute growth of Traffic of SMPK(7.485 MMT) w.r.t previous year.
- ➤ Improvement of rank from 6<sup>th</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> in cargo handling amongst the Major Ports.
- ➤ Highest rail borne cargo of 34.608 MMT (HDC: 28.814, KDS: 5.794).







On 8th April, 2023, Shri Sudhansh Pant, IAS, Secretary, MoPSW, laid the foundation stone for the rehabilitation of 7 NSD Old Berth and development of the back yard at N.S Dock, KDS at SMP Kolkata being executed at a cost of Rs. 80.74 crore. With fiscal support from the Ministry, this project will be a key infrastructure in improving port productivity in coming years.



# Auditing of firefighting facilities of oil jetties at HDC, SMPK

On 17th April, 2023, HDC, SMPK commenced weeklong auditing of firefighting facilities of all oil jetties being conducted by OISD experts including the unloading facilities of different users as per OISD-156 standard & recommendations with suggestions for further improvement.

# First containerised movement of cargo from SMP Kolkata to ICD Debagram, Siliguri

On 25<sup>th</sup> April, 2023, the first containerised cargo moved from SMP Kolkata to ICD Debagram, Siliguri by Pristine Logistics &Maersk Line. The consignment is to reach within the next two days and the venture is expected to attract traffic of North Bengal.





## **Commissioning of Barge Jal Ridhhi**

On 18th April, 2023, Dy. Chairman, HDC of SMPK commissioned Barge 'Jal Riddhi' at the HFTPL Jetty. With carrying capacity of 7600 MT, this is the largest barge handled by SMPK which will add a fillip to the lighterage operation at the Anchorages in the future.



#### Interactive session with members of ASIC

Interactive session was conducted by KDS, SMP Kolkata on 21.4.2023 with members of ASIC, where achievements of KDS in the last FY were appraised & initiatives to be taken for further enhanced performance and deliverance by Port in the current FY were discussed.

The following commitments for ensuring Safety healthy and wellness during discharge of work were reiterated on the occasion.

- ➤ Night navigation system at SMPK.
- Sustainable standards of ship recycling followed by Alang under Hong Kong convention.



#### **II CARGO THROUGHPUT:**

- > SMP, Kolkata handled 4.638 million metric tonnes (MMT) of cargo during April, 2023 vis-à-vis 4.333 MMT during April, 2022, registering an increase of 7.04%.
- ➤ HDC handled 3.420 MMT of cargo during April, 2023 vis-à-vis 3.048 MMT during April, 2022 (an increase of 12.20%). KDS handled 1.218 MMT of cargo in April, 2023 vis-à-vis 1.285 mt during April, 2022.
- ➤ HDC registered growth in respect of POL (Product), Iron Ore, Fertiliser and its Raw materials, Coking Coal, Other Coal / Coke, Vegetable Oil, Other Liquid, etc. while KDS registered growth in respect of Fertiliser, Other Coal / Coke, Timber, Pulses, Container etc. during April, 2023 visà-vis corresponding period of last year.

## **III CONTAINER TRAFFIC:**

SMP, Kolkata handled 60,610 TEUs (KDS: 49,582 & HDC: 11,028) during April, 2023 vis-à-vis 58,422 TEUs (KDS: 46,174 & HDC: 12,248) during April, 2022, an increase of 3.75%.

#### **IV SHIP TRAFFIC:**

During April, 2023, 262 ships (KDS: 106, HDC: 156) called at SMP, Kolkata vis-a-vis 229 ships (KDS: 92, HDC: 137) in April, 2022, an increase of 14.41%. 319 vessels (156 inward; 163 outward) passed through Eden Channel during April, 2023 to / from Haldia vis-à-vis 279 vessels (137 inward; 142 outward) during April, 2022.

## V COMPARATIVE PERFORMANCE:

SMP, Kolkata ranked 1st in handling of Coking/Other Coal and 2nd in handling of both Other Liquids & Other Misc. Cargo amongst Indian Major Ports during April 2023.

## VI RAILWAY TRAFFIC:

During April, 2023, SMP, Kolkata handled rail borne cargo of 2.806 MMT (HDC-2.37, KDS-0.436 MMT) against 2.719 MMT (HDC-2.18 MMT, KDS-0.539 MMT) in April, 2022, registering a growth of 3.2%. During April, 2023, 98 rakes were received and 103 dispatched at KDS; at HDC, 521 rakes were received and 519 were dispatched during the same period.
