5. PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS

A. Cargo Traffic:

- In April-June 2018, KoPT handled 15.129 million tonnes (mt) of cargo vis-a-vis 13.727 mt in Apr-June'17 registering 10.21% growth - 2nd highest among Indian Major Ports, much in excess of the average growth rate of 3.91% clocked by Major Ports. HDC handled 10.791 mt in April-June'18 vis-à-vis 9.508 mt in Apr-June'17 recording highest growth of 13.49% among Major Ports. KDS handled 4.338 mt of traffic in April-June, 2018 vis-à-vis 4.219 mt handled in Apr-June, 2017 registering a growth of 2.82%.
- KoPT registered growth in April-June'18 vis-a-vis Apr-June'17 in respect of LPG, Limestone, Thermal Coal, Coking Coal, Other Coal/Coke, Petroleum Coke, Iron & Steel, Timber, Salt, Cement Clinker, Gypsum, Container, Other Miscellaneous Cargo etc.

B. Container Traffic:

- KoPT handled 2,10,841 TEUs in April-June, 2018 vis-à-vis 1,88,707 TEUs in April-June'17 registering 11.73% growth. KoPT ranked 3rd amongst Major Ports in terms of Container traffic in Apr-June'18.
- In Apr-Jun'18, KDS handled 1,66,337 TEUs vis-à-vis 1,55,804 TEUs in Apr-Jun'17 – i.e. 6.76% growth, while HDC handled 44,504 TEUs in Apr-Jun'18 vis-à-vis 32,903 TEUs in Apr-Jun'17 – i.e. a high growth of 35.26%.

C. Comparative Performance:

- KoPT ranked 1st in Coking/Other Coal, 2nd in Other Liquids and 3rd in Container among Major Ports.
- KoPT ranked 5th in cargo handling among Indian Major Ports.

D. Ship Traffic:

- In Apr-June'18, KoPT handled 915 ships - the highest among Indian Major Ports.

E. Railway Traffic:

- In Apr-June'18, KoPT handled rail-borne traffic of 7.02 mt. (KDS-1.42 mt., HDC-5.60 mt.) against 6.23 mt. (KDS-1.43 mt., HDC-4.80 mt.) in Apr-June'17 i.e. a growth of 12.68%. In Apr-June'18, 344 trains were received and 352 despatched at KDS; at HDC, 1117 trains received and 1118 were despatched.

F. Major Achievements:

- In May, 2018, KDS of KoPT achieved highest ever monthly container handling of 58,482 TEUs which is 395 TEUs more than the previous highest of 58,087 TEUs handled in August, 2017.
- Highest container handling in a day by both RMQCs i.e. 1,260 TEUs was achieved at HDC on 14.05.2018, surpassing the earlier record of 1,194 TEUs attained on 30.03.2017.
- On 23.5.2018, members of Eminent Persons Group for India-Nepal Relations met Chairman, KoPT to study Nepal's transit and trade arrangements in Kolkata.
- Chairman, KoPT during a recent press meet assured various trade and shipping interests that ship repairing activities will resume in earnest at the Dry Docks from Aug-Sept'18. KoPT and Cochin Shipyard Ltd. signed an agreement on 17.3.18 for Operations & Maintenance of Ship Repair Facility at NSD.
- Chairman, KoPT was part of a high profile entourage which accompanied the Hon'ble Union Minister of Road, Transport, Highways & Shipping visiting Republic of Korea from 9th to 12th April, 2018 showcasing various aspects of port development, investment opportunities at Indian Ports / Maritime Sector.
- Introduction of Truck Chit System at KDS under Ease of Doing Business will enable easy loading of containers facilitating restacking operation, thereby saving time.
- On 20.06.2018, the 1st Mini Cape vessel, M.V. Kishore with 54,000 tonnes of cargo arrived at KoPT Sagar Anchorage for the first time and unloading commenced started with two recently installed Floating Cranes.
- Cargo operation at Floating Barge Jetty outside HDC lock gate commenced on 16.6.18 by discharging limestone.
- On 21.06. 2018, KoPT floated tenders for O&M of three parking lots under 'Ease of doing Business' for container trade.
- The first ever midnight city tour touching the important land and watermarks of the historic port-city of Kolkata, generating huge enthusiasm, was conducted on 16.06.18.
- World Environment Day was observed on 5.6.18 at KDS & HDC through tree plantation. On the theme "Beat Plastic Pollution", plastic removal drive was taken at Man-of-War jetty by CISF to graduate towards a plastic free environment.
- As part of the joint initiative with CONCOR to start a new route to Nepal for transit cargo through India's gateway ports, the first container train from NSD of KDS, KoPT to Jogbani, Nepal, was flagged off in April'18.
- 1128 vessels (562 inward; 566 outward) have passed through Eden channel in April-June, 2018 to/from Haldia.
